*Who should attend the Ground School classes?*

*Every student pilot who has not taken and passed the FAA private pilot written test.*

*When should I attend?*

*As early as possible in your training. The more you learn the more it will apply to your flying skills. You will make better progress in flying. It will decrease the number of hours you need to spend with your flight instructor, thus lowering the cost of training.*

*I urge you to take this opportunity to attend AFI's 8 ground school modules. What you will learn will increase your flying skills, build your confidence and prepare you to pass the written test.*
